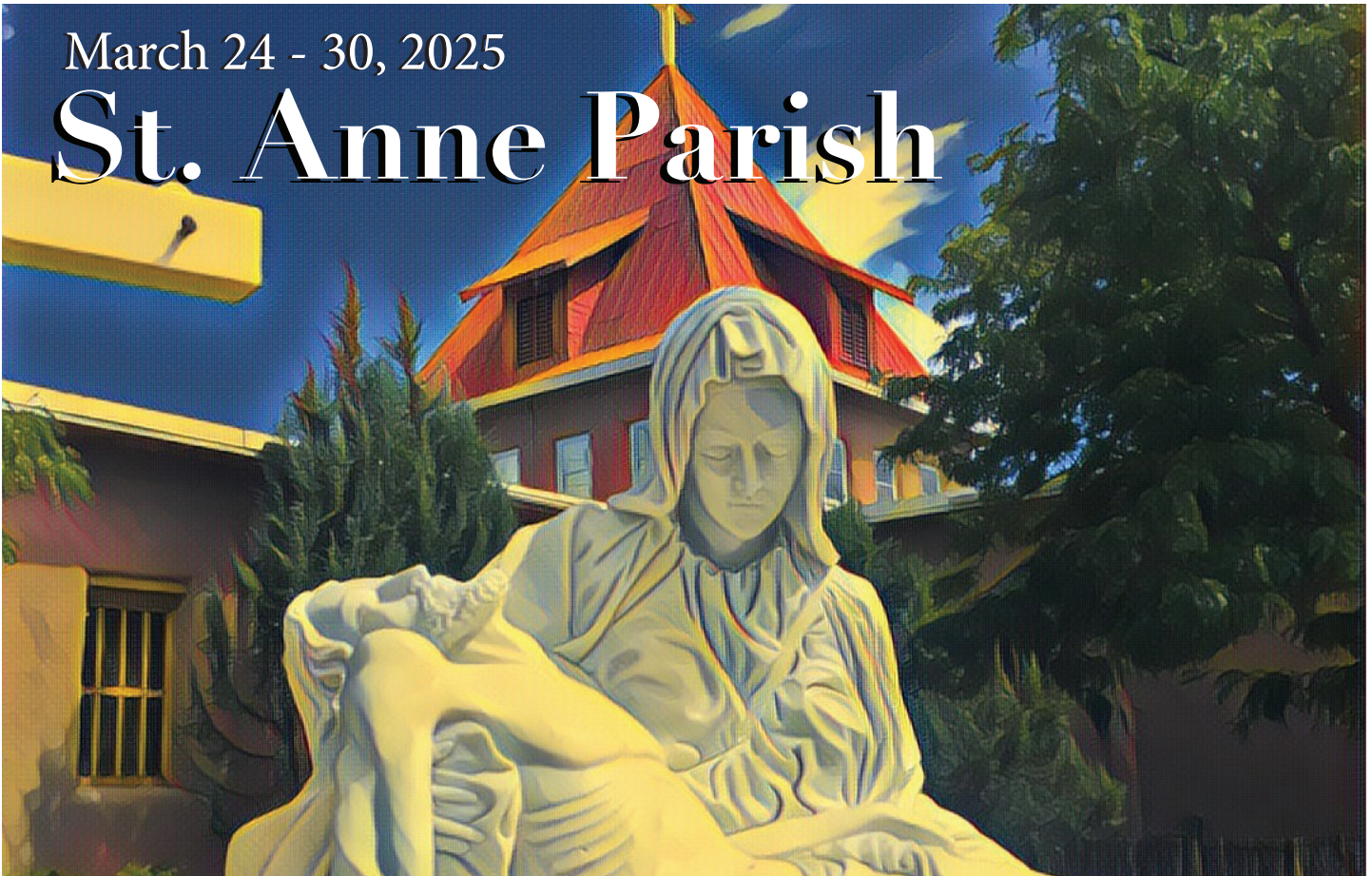

The Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA) was created in 1903 and is one of the oldest and largest organizations of Catholic women in the Americas. It is an organization with over 55,000 members in 1,150 courts (local chapters) in 45 states across the country and in Puerto Rico, Mexico, Guam, and the Virgin Islands.

Court Santa Ana No. 2309 is part of that national organization and was instituted by with 21 women at St. Anne Parish in 1989. Our motto, "Unity and Charity," calls on us "to donate to charities, administer scholarship programs and strive to be helping hands where there is pain, poverty, sorrow, or sickness."

We worship together, pray together, and help each other to be the best Catholic women we can possibly be. Our members give their time, energy, stewardship, hearts, and financial assistance to help others in the service of Christ. We enjoy each other's company at our monthly meetings and our shared spiritual and charitable works.

We work hard for our parish and our community. We do this by:

- * awarding scholarships for St. Anne parishioners who can use the financial assistance to receive a Catholic education**
- * baking cakes for the Cake Walk at our annual Parish Fiestas**
- * working with Helping Hands with monthly donations and by supporting the need**
