[44] The Origin of Your Destiny is in Heaven

There lived a Jesuit priest named Francesco Geronimo, who was a professor and later spent the last 40 years of his life in Naples preaching the eternal truths for salvation of souls. He was an example of what it means for a priest to be on fire for the Kingdom of God. In September 1696, Donna Anna Catherine Cavalieri gave birth to a boy, and Fr Geronimo was invited to baptize him. On that occasion, he looked at that baby and made two prophesies to his mom. The first was that he won't see death until he attained 90. The second is that she gave birth to a future Bishop. Years later, these two prophesies came through. That baby grew to become a renowned Bishop of the See of St Agatha of the Goths and died close to age 91. He is whom we know today as St Alphonsus Liguori, who providentially, on May 26, 1839, was canonized a saint same day with Fr Geronimo who baptized him. The other saints canonized with them were John Joseph of the Cross, Veronica Giuliani, Pacific of San Severino, and Ignatius of Laconi.

The above story is always repeated in different ways in every human being including you who are reading this. It tells us if God has a dream, it is every human being. Therefore, every baby is an unfolding mystery, and every mystery is pointing to our God who alone owns time and space. What this means is that each of us who are born in time and space has a history (his or her story), but that story began already in the depths of eternity from the bosom of the Eternal Father.

Jesus, our Brother, by coming into time and space to die for us, consequently, tells us that whatever burden or pain that might make us think that life is not worth living, comes from the Evil One. For as St Bernard teaches, love has a size, a size that is immeasurable. Its width is God and its length is eternity. But our participation in time is a living foretaste of eternity. So, each of us is precious to God who made us not to destroy us but to share in His joy. That is why St Veronica Giuliani, mentioned above, exclaimed before she died: "Tell everyone love has been found." Yet, that love first found us. May this be an assurance of hope for anyone and everyone giving up on life, for God has never given and will never give up on you. So do not give up on yourself. You are a great destiny! You are a mystery! You are a gift to humanity, because whenever you check the clock, it tells you that at that time and all times, you are immensely loved by the Lord of time. God has been writing your history even before you were a baby, and He continues to write your history till you go receive your reward from Him in eternity.
