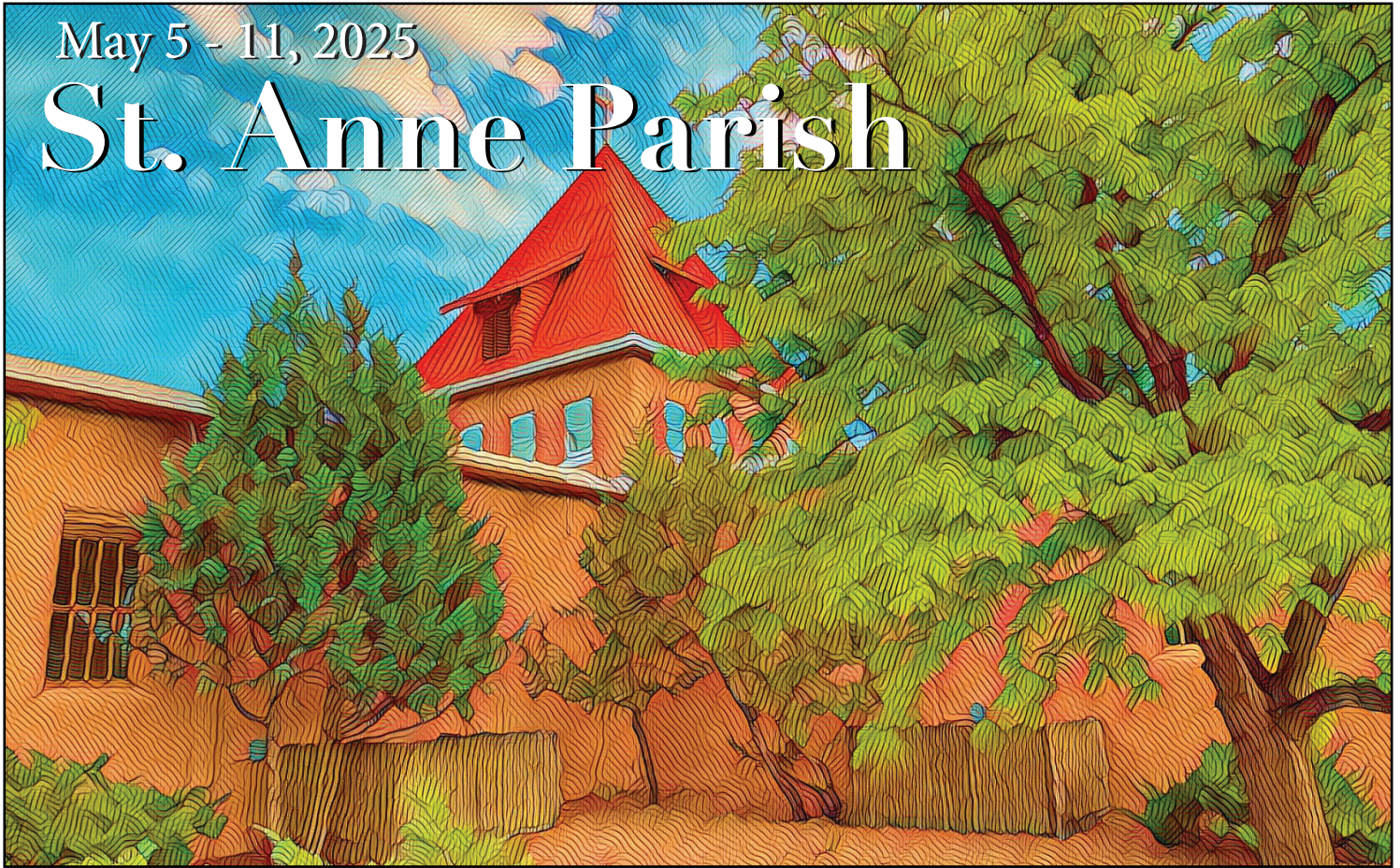

for their own children.

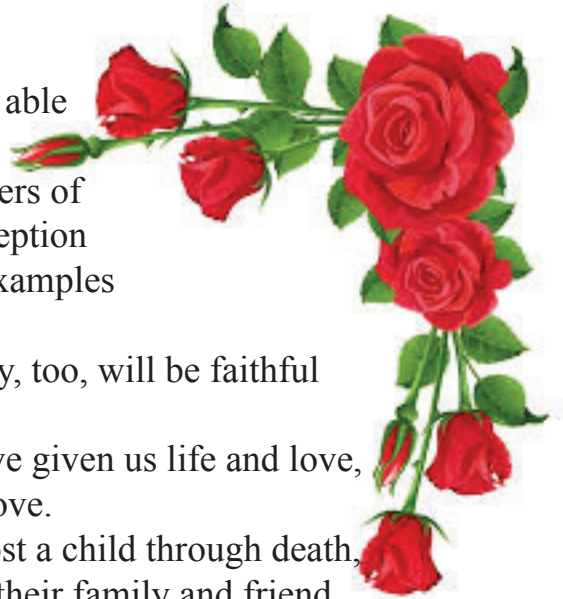
Pray for their children, so that they, too, will be faithful
