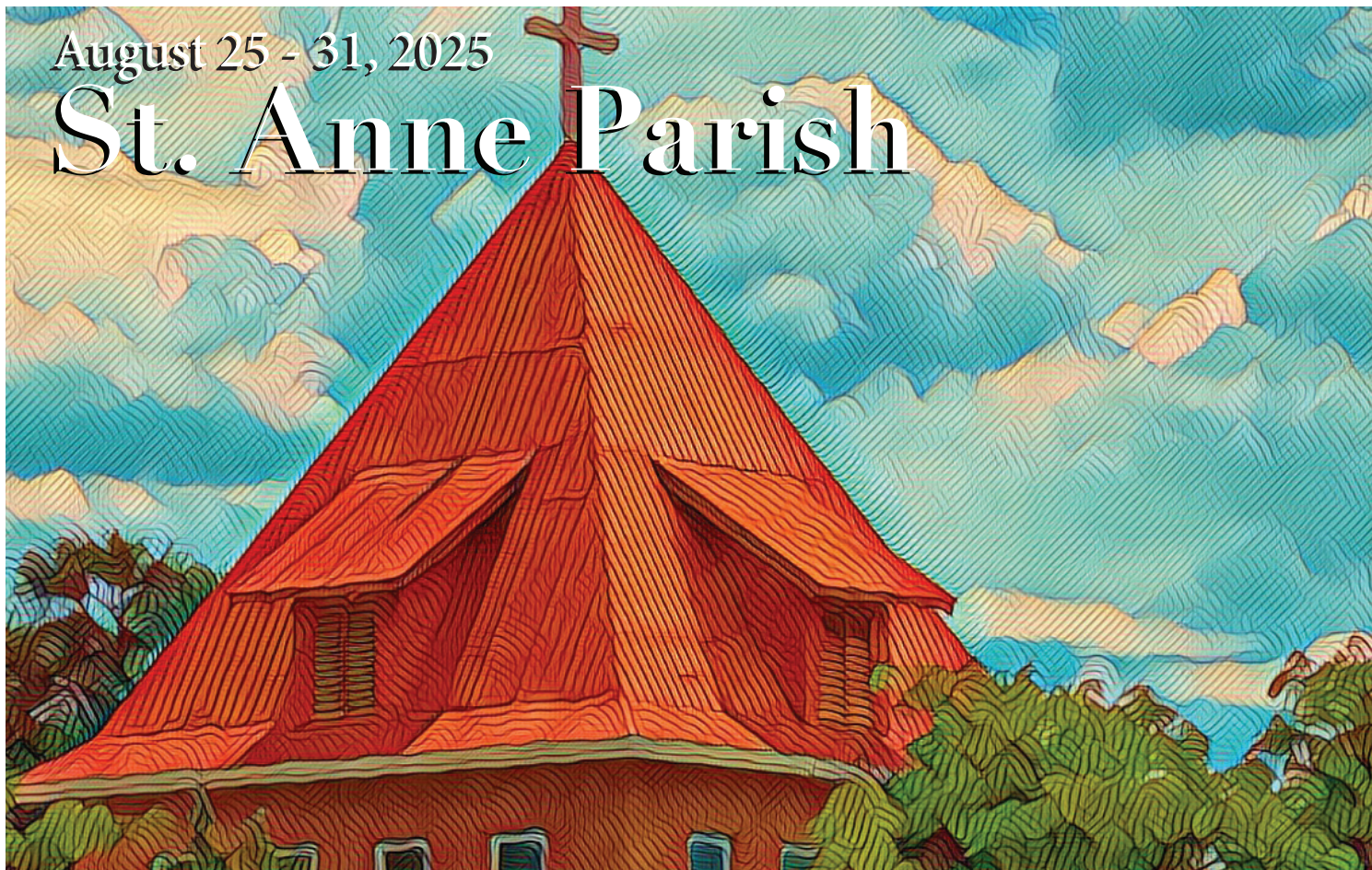

## Siblings of Jesus Series

### [8] Chastity is the Life of God

How does it sound to you to hear that God has a life? Sounds crazy or kinda cool? Imagine you having a WhatsApp conversation with Our Lord if Jesus was to use a phone, and He asks you: "How are you doing?" Afterwards when you ask Him: "What is your life like?" I think Jesus will reply to you something like: "Lol." In our social media today, LOL stands for "Laugh out loud," but in God's own media, LOL could stand for "Life of Love." What then is God's own media? The thought of God fills the saints with reverence and veneration! That is why St Anselm of Canterbury defines God as "that which no greater can be conceived of." The life of love, that is, the divine LOL is that which makes us capable of seeing God. Here, I propose the "ity" suffix, which is one of the formulas of sanctity. The name of that life is Chast-ity which is synonymous with pur-ity, which needs to be promoted and practiced in everywhere as a way of overcoming iniqu-ity in order to be happy in etern-ity, which is the joy of Christian-ity. This is because our Lord has taught that Chast-ity has a blessing: "Blessed are the pure of heart," that is, chaste, "for they shall see God" (Matt 5:8). What the Lord means here is this is a condition to be in Heaven, and that chastity is not compromised for anything else. Therefore, we must strive to live chastly: either we are chaste or not, which is equivalent of saying that our life must be led for God and for God alone or not. If God makes this promise to everyone, then He is serious about it. This is an invitation. This is a direction. This is an instruction. This is a consolation. For this world presents us with all forms of unchaste things which promise us satisfaction, yet the satisfaction is short lived and sets us on the road of addiction. Pornography, adultery, fornication, and all forms of immorality are opponents to chastity and will never lead us to life of God in Heaven, but rather damnation in Hell. In anticipation of the coming articles, we shall see how to overcome these opponents in order to acquire a chaste life, which I define as the life that is of God, the life that is for God, the life that is in God, the life that is from God, the life that is by God, and the life that is God. These six facets of chastity must be kept secure in our hearts. If we are attentive, we can hear Jesus say to us, His siblings, "Subscribe to this channel, and like and share it with others." God's channel or media is the Scriptures and like modern YouTubers and content creators, He wants us to help Him gain more followers by how we live our lives. We Remember, if you do not try to be chaste in this life, we may forfeit eternal life.
